Due October 14th

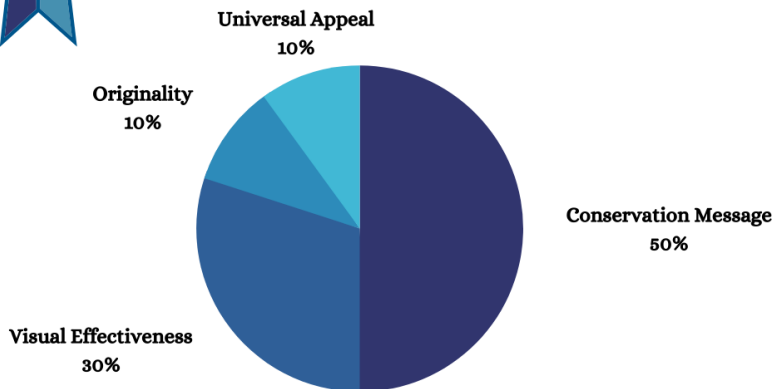
## Poster Instructions:

- The theme; “Healthy Forests-Healthy Communities” must be on the poster
- Double-check spelling before using markers/colored pencils
- Must be the students’ original artwork
- Don’t put students’ name or school on the front of the poster
- Use white 14X22” poster board. (regular poster board cut in half)
- Tape entry form to the back after parent and guardian has signed
